One Goal has seasonally fought not to keep score when in fact, many parents, coaches, and players themselves know the final outcome.

If One Goal is to differentiate itself from other leagues, what better way to do it than in teaching parents, players, and coaches that the final score does not dictate success. We find it more beneficial for One Goal not to run from score, rather embrace it, and rise above societal expectations. If score keeping is the only thing that distinguishes One Goal from other leagues then faces a much bigger problem. We hope that everyone sees this as more than a sport organization.
